e-DISHA Ekal Sewa Kendra



The first Ekal Sewa Kendra at Kaithal received CSI-Nihilent "**2nd Runners-up award**" at Pune. The e-DISHA project was **published in the compendium of 9th National e-Governance conference**. One District level e-DISHA Center (DleDC) has been established at all districts. These DleDCs are providing hassle free citizen services through a single window in a transparent way. DleDCs centers have become very popular among masses in a short span of time.

State Portal:

The web portal www.haryana.gov.in is a single window web based delivery of information services at the State level. More than 15 Public services are being provided on official web portal. This portal provides a linkage to departments and district websites. **Project had received "Merit Citation" National Award** at 7th national e-Governance conference. State portal is being redesigned to give a new look & feel and being enhanced with online grievances handling, Content Management System and other G2G, G2C, G2B, G2E services. All transactional & information services will be provided through State Portal.

e-Governance Gateway Services

The State web servers, e-mail servers and Internet gateways, based on VSATs, RF links and MLLs and having heterogeneous platforms are operating at NIC-Haryana Civil Secretariat Centre. The interactive contents of major state websites and official e-mail accounts are hosted on these servers. More than 5000 official e-mail accounts operational on e-mail server and an exclusive e-mail directory has also been published. Web Services like development, hosting, updating, ".gov.in" domain registration & activation services, website security audit facilitation, VPN & CMS for website updation & data uploading are provided regularly to departments & organizations of state & centre.

e-Courts



Sub Ordinate Judicial Courts: SOCJIS: Workflow based Justice Delivery & Judicial Information System for Sub Ordinate Courts implemented at Ambala and Panchkula district judicial court complexes, in a Network environment. The PCs installed in all subordinate courts located at 40 locations in Haryana. Laptops have been provided to all Judges under courts project. All Sub Ordinate Court complexes planned to be networked as per national e-Court project.

High Court of Punjab, Haryana & UT Chandigarh: A Network of more than 900 nodes and Network Management Centre has been set-up at High Court. The Integrated Software for High Court workflow automation (**ISHiCo**) has been developed and implemented. The daily cause list, daily orders & judgments are being published on the High court website.

e-Office Suite

A suite of G2G Packages has been standardized across the state. Suite of packages include: Personnel Information System, Payroll System, Diary Dispatch (Dak) Monitoring, Court Cases Monitoring, Government Accounting System, Office Inventory Maintenance, Centralized File Movement & Tracking Information System (CeFMatIS). Various departments, boards and corporations at their offices at State Hq and district Hq are implementing the various packages of e-Office suite.

e-District

The e-District project has been introduced in the state. A comprehensive network (LAN), a modern IT training lab, District level e-DISHA Centers has been established in each district mini secretariat. A suite of Office automation software packages for district & revenue administration has been developed and being implemented on district LANs. All major functions of Revenue Administration in an integrated & network environment are planned to be implemented Rohtak and Jind districts under e-District MMP funding of NeGP.

Capacity Building

The SIT has established 4 IT training lab at State Hq and one IT lab at each district. IT Awareness training is being conducted regularly by NIC staff at State and districts with the assistance of contractual faculty from State e-Gov society and DITS. More than 17000 employees have already been trained till date. The general IT training, Project specific training, Students projects, technical updates and conducting of workshops/seminars is done regularly. Hartron has established 48 Nos. Franchise centers for imparting IT education across the state.
