

e-Governance in Haryana

Haryana is proud of being the state with highest per capita income in the country. The Software & IT/ITES/BPO services exports from the State have increased from Rs. 400 Crores in the year 1998-99 to more than **Rs. 14,000 Crores** in the year 2006-07. There has been an increase of about 31% over the year 2005-06. The E-Readiness Assessment Report – **2006** of India, released by DIT, Govt of India has ranked **Haryana as leader. The State e-Governance projects have already received 14 prestigious national awards.**
