

## **ICT enabled e-Services & Achievements of NIC in Haryana as on 31/03/2011**

### **Central Government level MMPs & other Projects implemented in Haryana**

1. **Passport:** The Network management & operations at Regional Passport Office Chandigarh. Implementation of back-end of PCIS(Passport Control and Issuing System) and PIRS(Passport Index Retrieval System). Decentralized Passport Applications Acceptance System was implemented at all districts. Now back-end services support and Services on existing Passports are being provided at RPO Chandigarh. Decentralized Passport application processing system is being implemented for the district attached with RPO Delhi.
2. **Pensions and GPF Portal:** An interactive and comprehensive dynamic employees Portal for Office of Accountant General Haryana for GPF information & pensions is developed & implemented for all employees of Haryana. It is updated regularly.
3. **Customs & Central Excise:** A LAN has been made operational at Customs Office Ballabh Garh (Faridabad). The Export/ Import system of customs is being implemented. Technical support is provided on regular basis.
4. **e-Posts:** Major district level Post offices have been connected with 2 MBPS LL through NIC District centers for e-services to citizens. Computerized Postal Life Insurance, Postal Accounting System are being implemented at Haryana Postal Circle. VC facility established in Office of CPMG Haryana at Ambala Cantt.
5. **Directorate of Enforcement Project:** Technical support is being provided to Enforcement Directorate office at Chandigarh for implementing ICT project.
6. **National Unique ID Project:** Technical inputs provided in working out a standard citizen data repository, in-line with UID. The MoU was signed between State Govt and UIDAI on 10<sup>th</sup> June, 2010. Guided departments in UIDAI workshop on 27/08/2010. Worked KYR and KYR+ data elements for establishing Haryana State Citizens Services database. UID implementation processes has also worked out. FCR Haryana has been appointed as UID Registrar for Haryana. Technical support is being provided to FCR, Food & Supply Department and State IT department on UID related technical activities.
7. **EPFO (Employees Provident Fund Organization) Computerization Project:** Supported implementation of first pilot at Karnal and Faridabad. Implementation support extended to Punjab and Himachal also.
